The City of Port Coquitlam is collecting public input about existing and future transit services in our community, as well as the Coast Mountain Bus Company's 2009-2010 Service Plan. A subsidiary of TransLink, Coast Mountain Bus Company provides bus, commuter rail and SeaBus services to Metro Vancouver.
